In response to Pope Francis's urgent call to purification and renewal in 2016, Christ the King Parish began its very own **ADOPRE Prayer Ministry**.

What is the ADOPRE Prayer Ministry?

Prayer Ministers answer the call to pray for their pastors, deacon and/or seminarian, the needs of the parish, and individual parishioners who request prayer. They do this by remembering these intentions in their daily personal prayer, as well as during times in personal Adoration and attendance at Sunday and weekday Masses, whenever possible.

Prayer Ministers will be offered a **Member Card** as a sign of their commitment, will have their name added to the **Prayer Minister Registry** to be prayed for by all members, and will receive notification of ongoing prayer requests by email.

IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID – 19 Pandemic, **Prayer Ministers** are invited to participate in a Telephone Ministry, an outreach to *help prevent isolation from the parish and one another during the time of CoVid-19*. Telephone Ministers will be asked to call fellow parishioners who have agreed to be contacted, to lift them up in prayerful conversation and to pray for them, and possibly with them.
