

Updated Oct 3, 2020

It is with great joy that we can announce the resumption of the celebration of the Mass at Christ the King Parish, even though Mass will be celebrated with a reduced number of participants present. In accordance with the provincial guidelines for gatherings Christ the King Parish has developed a process which will ensure fairness and equity amongst our parishioners desiring to attend Mass. Please be reminded that, as per Archbishop Donald Bolen's letter, dispensation to forgo Mass attendance is still in effect.

Christ the King Parish will be utilizing the functionality of a database program in order collect the names of those desiring to attend.

- 1) Information required;
 - a. First and last name of **ONE** member of the household (only those living in the home)
 - b. Address (street # and Street)
 - c. How many in the household that will be attending Mass
 - d. How many attending Mass that will receive the Eucharist
 - e. How many receiving the Eucharist will require low gluten
 - f. Email address (or phone # if no email available)
 - g. First & Second choice of Mass to attend

- 2) Names of those wishing to attend Mass will be collected by Deacon Kevin Harty by one of the following options (email is preferred)
 - a. Email kpharty@accesscomm.ca Please use "CtK Mass attendance" in your email subject line
 - b. Phone (306) 537-7192 - leave a voice mail if prompted

- 3) The database info will be continually updated. You need only relay information once.

- 4) Effective August 8th a monthly schedule has been put into place, and as much as possible parishioners will be assigned to their preferential Mass. The New monthly schedules will be relayed no later than the last week of the month.
 - a. Please verify your intent to attendant Mass each week no later than Friday Noon.
 - i. By reply email, to kpharty@accesscomm.ca, attendance receipt"
 - ii. By phone (306) 537-7192
 - b. As we are overbooked for each Mass by 30% it is essential we receive confirmations to attend Mass.
 - c. **As our registration numbers have increased significantly during the month of Sept. Not all registrants for the 5:00PM Sat, 9:00AM and 11:00AM Sun. may be able to attend. If the Mass has already been filled when your confirmation is received you will be informed as such. Your options at that time would be;**
 - i. **Arrive at your scheduled Mass and wait until 5 minutes prior to start. At that time if one of the families that have confirmed attendance does not show you will be seated.**
OR
 - ii. **2) You can request to be scheduled into the 6:30 Mass Saturday evening, for this weekend, as it is still under capacity.**

- 5) If you are not able to attend the Mass you have been assigned, or if the number of attendees in your household has changed please contact Deacon Kevin, as per contact info above.
 - a. Each Attendee must have taken the Public Health Assessment questionnaire prior to attending Mass which can be found by clicking the following link;

 - i. If the link does not work copy it into your web browser.
 - b. You will be asked prior to entering the church if you have taken the questionnaire.
 - c. Contact info, as per #1, is required for contact tracing in the event someone in your household becomes sick.

- 6) Mass Attendance Notes:
 - a. **Please arrive a minimum of 15 minutes early in order that instructions can be given and social distancing / health requirements can be adhered to.**
 - i. **At 5 minutes prior to Mass your seats may be reassigned to someone waiting.**
 - b. Please ensure social distancing is maintained while entering the church.
 - c. Enter and exit thru the main doors on Garnet Street.
 - d. Our Greeter will meet you at the door, maintaining social distancing, to:
 - i. Check off names of attendees / households
 - ii. Ensure Public Health Assessment questionnaire has been completed
 - iii. Provide liturgical celebration procedures specific to Covid19
 - iv. Direct attendees to open pews for seating

- 7) Mass times effective Saturday May 30 2019 until further notice;
 - a. Tuesdays 9:00 am (no Preregistration required, arrive 15 minutes early)
 - b. Wednesdays 9:00 am (no Preregistration required, arrive 15 minutes early)
 - c. Thursdays 9:00 am (no Preregistration required, arrive 15 minutes early)
 - d. Fridays 9:00 am (no Preregistration required, arrive 15 minutes early)
 - e. Saturdays 5:00 pm & 6:30 pm
 - f. Sundays 9:00 am & 11:00 am
